#### III. Significant Events:

#### A. Status of TCEQ Violations.

This continues to be a work in process. On June 21, 2023, management met with Engineer Don Rauschuber, P.E. to review the 3G draft response and further the process of drafting the CT Study ("contact time"). We anticipate requesting an extension of time to provide the total response. This should be completed within the next 30 days.

#### B. Lake Line Crossing.

On June 20, 2023, management issued a Notice to Proceed to 4L Utilities, LLC., on the Lakeline Pipeline Crossing Project. The project amount is \$132,480. However, we anticipate additional costs with issues that are now unforeseen. As requested by the terms of the quote, a deposit check was issued in the amount of \$18,630. (See 2 Estimates attached).

The week of July 3, 2023, equipment and materials have been mobilized to begin the project. The actual pipe bursting is scheduled to begin on Monday, July, 10, 2023. On Friday, July 7, 2023, management arranged to have temporary water service established with Corix. This temporary service will be turned on that day and will continue until the project is completed. We anticipate to project duration to be about 2 weeks.

#### C. Generator Status / Quote for a replacement Control Panel.

From last meeting, it was reported that Mr. Bobby Sanford with Electric-S performed an on-site review of the generator and found that the alternator in the current control panel is inoperable, not serviceable and is no longer being manufactured.

Among other things, in a power outage event the control panel allows only critical components to operate thereby reducing the amps needed to keep the system in water. Electric-S has provided a proposal to provide a new control panel, a copy of which is attached. This will be a new factory fabricated control panel at a cost of \$9,500.00, with delivery of 14-16 weeks. Management reached out to 5S Service Company for an additional quote for this work several months ago, have not received a response.

Management recommends that 3G look favorably on this proposal from Electric -S at this time. This quoted price is in line with control panels purchased for other water systems.

D. Several attachments to this report are not yet available and will be provided during the meeting. These include Directors Reports for 3 Routes, Flushing and Leak Report and the Monthly Credit Card Use Report. (See quote attached from Electric-S).

#### Corix Utilities (Texas) Retail Service Agreement

- PURPOSE: Corix Utilities (Texas) is responsible for protecting the drinking water supply from contamination or 1. pollution which could result from improper system construction or configuration on the retail connection owner's side of the meter. The purpose of this service agreement is to notify each customer of the restrictions which are in place to provide this protection. The public water system enforces these restrictions to ensure the public health and welfare. Each retail customer must sign this agreement before Corix Utilities (Texas) will begin service. In addition, when service to an existing retail connection has been suspended or terminated, the water system will not re-establish service unless it has a copy of this agreement signed by the current Customer.
- 11. RESTRICTIONS: The following unacceptable practices are prohibited by State regulations.
  - A. No direct connection between the public drinking water supply and a potential source of contamination is permitted. Potential sources of contamination shall be isolated from the public water system by an air-gap or an appropriate backflow prevention device.
  - B. No cross-connection between the public drinking water supply and a private water system is permitted. These potential threats to the public drinking water supply shall be eliminated at the service connection by the installation of an air-gap or a reduced pressure-zone backflow prevention device (RPZ).
  - C. No connection which allows water to be returned to the public drinking water supply is permitted.
  - D. No pipe or pipe fitting which contains more than 0.25% lead may be used for the installation or repair of plumbing at any connection which provides water for human use.
  - E. No solder or flux which contains more than 0.2% lead can be used for the installation or repair of plumbing at any connection which provides water for human use.
- SERVICE AGREEMENT: The following are the terms of the service agreement between Corix Utilities (Texas) III. and the customer.
  - A. The Water System will maintain a copy of this agreement as long as the Customer and/or the premises is connected to the Water System.
  - B. The Customer shall allow his property to be inspected for possible cross-connections and other potential contamination hazards. These inspections shall be conducted by the Water System or its designated agent prior to initiating any new water service, when there is reason to believe that cross-connections or other
  - potential contamination hazards exist; or after any major changes to the private water distribution facilities. The Water System shall notify the Customer in writing of any cross-connection or other potential contamination hazard which has been identified during the initial inspection or the periodic reinspection.
  - D. The Customer shall immediately remove or adequately isolate any potential cross-connection or other
  - potential contamination hazards on their premises.

    The Customer shall, at its expense, properly install, test, and maintain any backflow prevention required by the Water System or PRV. A PRV located on the Customer's side of the water meter is recommended by the Water System for all connections. Copies of all testing and maintenance records shall be provided to the Water System upon request.
- ENFORCEMENT: If the Customer fails to comply with the terms of the Service Agreement, the Water System IV. shall, at its option, either terminate service or properly install, test, and maintain an appropriate backflow prevention device at the service connection. Any and all expenses associated with the enforcement of this agreement shall be billed to the Customer.
