Significant Events

TCEQ Proposed Agreed Order

3G fined 2400 for not meeting TCEQ's ordering provisions Original violation was sent in September of 2020

Violations include:

- 1. Wells not plugged/plugged (Patrick cannot find a plugging report)
- 2. Additional filter needed (submitted and waiting on approval of filter system from TCEQ, submitted July 1st) Jack Schults is working on filter requirements.
- 3. Pressure tank (Patrick has exhausted his research if an engineer worked on tank) No evidence the tank was designed by an engineer.

This list needs to be taken care of in the next 6 months. Discussions ensued about additional deadlines and TCEQ's allegation of plugging wells in the past without notifying them

Patrick says Videll Drilling found an invoice/plugging report, and they have three plugging reports, Patrick is in the process of getting those reports.

Patrick says 3G needs to pay the fine and agree to the order because 3G could not provide the documents within the proper time frame.

The fine was added to the bottom of the spreadsheet of invoices, and we will pay the fine.

We need new fencing around some wells, which must be 8 ft tall or 6 ft with three rows of bob wire. In the future we will need new fences. 4 wells and one well complies.

Discussions ensued about new fencing.

Collins wants monthly updates on progress of meeting ordering provisions.

Master meter has arrived and is for Golden Beach

E. Well Controls and Emergency Call out System

Radios are now in for wells. Discussions ensued about analog auto dialer.

A motion was made by Jeff to approve an analog capable audio dialer at a cost not to succeed 6,000, seconded by Cody and approved by all.

Patrick has been in touch with Llano County about road repairs. Nancy brought up 507 Elm Circle that needs to be repaired and mowed.

F. Meter Test for 595 Golden Beach Drive

Discussion ensued about increasing tariffs for meter checks. It is \$125 for meter testing and that does not include taking it to get tested. Right now are tariff reads \$75 /meter testing. Collin will look at tariff list for next meeting agenda.
